



VEHICLE CONDITION GRADES

The grading system offers a general description of the vehicles entered in our online sales. Exterior conditions are graded within a range of A to E. Each vehicle is inspected and a matrix based value allocated for the cost of repair and a generic cost of a replacement part. The total value is used to determine the vehicles grade. Interior conditions are graded within a range of 1 to 3 in accordance with the standards set out below.

EXTERIOR CONDITION

Grade A

A clean vehicle in a condition commensurate with its age and mileage. This may include minor damage such as chips and scratches that may be remedied with touch-ins and polishing and the replacement of minor parts. The cost of these repairs is estimated to be in the region of £100.

Grade B

This vehicle will require a small amount of SMART repair, local paint repairs and the possible replacement of minor parts, up to a cost of approximately £200.

Grade C

The vehicle may require up to two panels of body-shop repair, replacement parts or a cumulative amount of SMART repair up to a cost of approximately £300.

Grade D

The vehicle may require up to three panels of body-shop repair, replacement parts or a cumulative amount of SMART repair up to a total cost in the region of £500.

Grade E

The vehicle will be in a poor condition requiring a high level of refurbishment to achieve a retail standard.

INTERIOR CONDITION

Grade 1

Clean and commensurate with age and mileage, but may need a standard valet

Grade 2

Unclean and possibly stained and will require a professional valet and possible SMART repair to achieve a retail standard.

Grade 3

Stained and damaged and may require replacement parts.
